Pacific Armatechnica (PATEC) worked up several frangible anti-materiel discarding-sabot projectiles in the early 1990s

Not quite good readable, but with a magnifying glass I could read most of it:

**Info:**

The plastic sabot may not be original to this round.

It is a APDS-T marked PATEC manufactured sabot, while the Mk149Mod0 had **no** tracer....

Patec was active in the 90's, while this round dates back to the 60's.

Original sabot should (as far as I know) be plain black with no markings (see Mk149 mod 1)
